

# « GET INVOLVED » TRAINING

We hereby cordially invite you to the « *Get Involved* » training.

This training, organized by our three organizations, ASTI/HUT/Croix-Rouge luxembourgeoise with the support of the Ministry of Family Affairs, Solidarity, Living Together and Reception of Refugees has as a goal to train volunteers wishing to engage with displaced populations seeking refuge in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. The training will address the three themes described below:

## 1. Volunteering, limits and opportunities (duration 2h)

- 1.1. Background, experience, and skills of displaced population looking for refuge in the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg
- 1.2. The volunteer approach and conflict prevention
- 1.3. Mental health and the psychological approach with displaced populations

## 2. Introduction to interculturality (duration 2h)

- 2.1. Discovery of intercultural identity
- 2.2. Understanding the mechanisms at play during an intercultural meeting

## 3. Legal and social context of the asylum procedure (duration 2h)

- 3.1. Status and rights of applicants and beneficiaries of international protection and beneficiaries of temporary protection
- 3.2. The different actors in support of DPI/BPI/DPT
